Minimum 30 years' experience, out of which minimum 20 years working experience should be in Petroleum Refinery/Pipeline or Petrochemical Projects/ any Indian Government Owned Engineering Consultancy Service Provider.

#### **4.0 JOB DESCRIPTION**

Scope of the work would include but not limited to the following:-

- Providing specialized guidance and assistance for development of construction methodology for all construction activities including review and approval of construction procedures and methodology.

- Review contractor's resource and schedules.
- Carryout construction supervision activities based on the approved construction drawings.
- Deviations, extra items, AHIR items, time extension etc. of the contractors are to be analyzed based on EPCM's recommendations on immediate basis to NRL whenever such occurrence is envisaged.
- Participate in monthly/weekly progress review meetings with EIL/Vendors.
- Inspection/ Expediting of equipment/Materials being manufactured by vendors including contractors supplied items wherever need arise.
- Construction Management & Supervision for PNCPL & COIT jobs
- Scheduling & monitoring of Project Pre Commissioning activities.
- Project Cost Control, Management & Monitoring.
- Risk Management of the project along with the detailed Risk analysis.
- Participation in technical discussions including review of documents related to pipeline project including crude oil terminal.
- Assisting in tender document, technical bid analysis, represent owner in the interaction with engineering with contractors and vendors.
- Supervise activities covered under the scope of EPCM, suggest corrective inputs wherever required including design, engineering etc.
- Review of engineering and supplier documents/ drawing along with EPCM consultant, wherever necessary.
- Assist in resolving site engineering issues, supervision of construction, if necessary etc.
- Assist in following up with statutory bodies seeking approvals, wherever required.
- Assist in any other important assignments not mentioned above but considered essential in the interest of the project.
